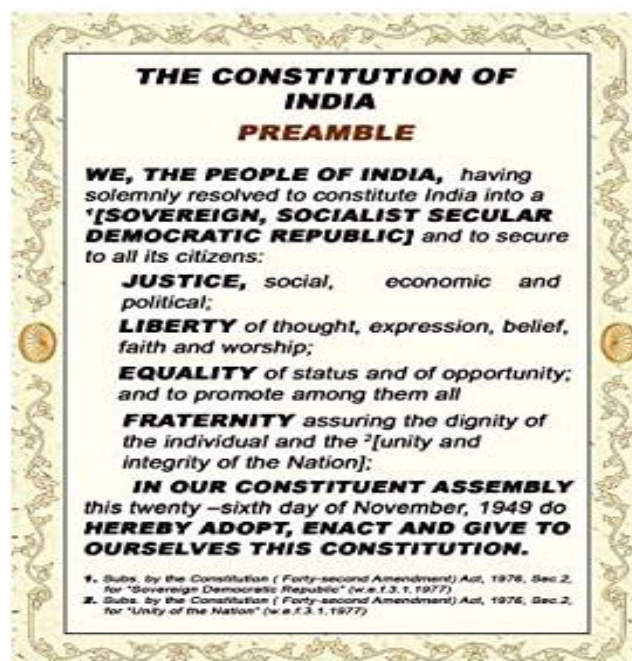
INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY CELEBRATION
