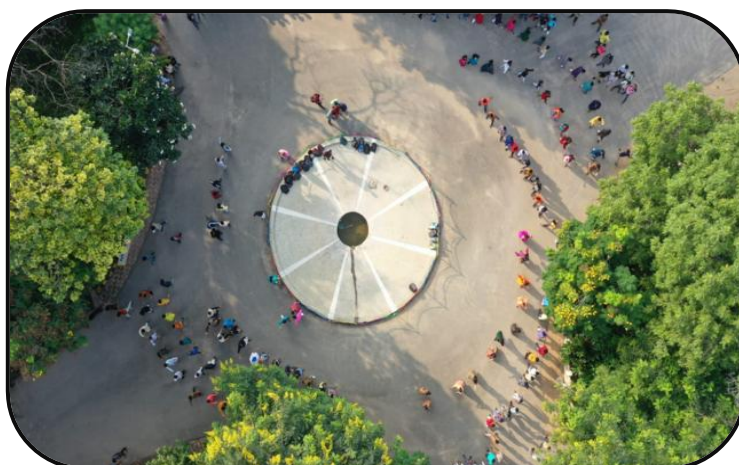
15th August celebration
