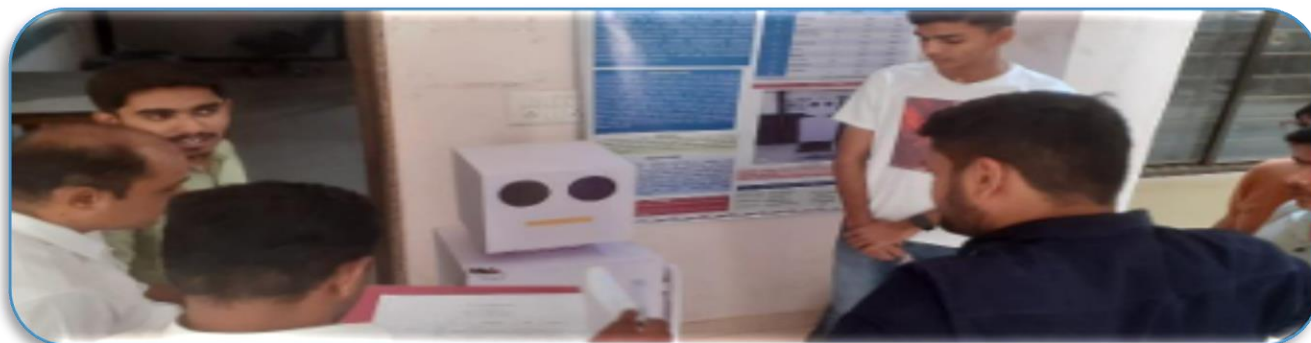

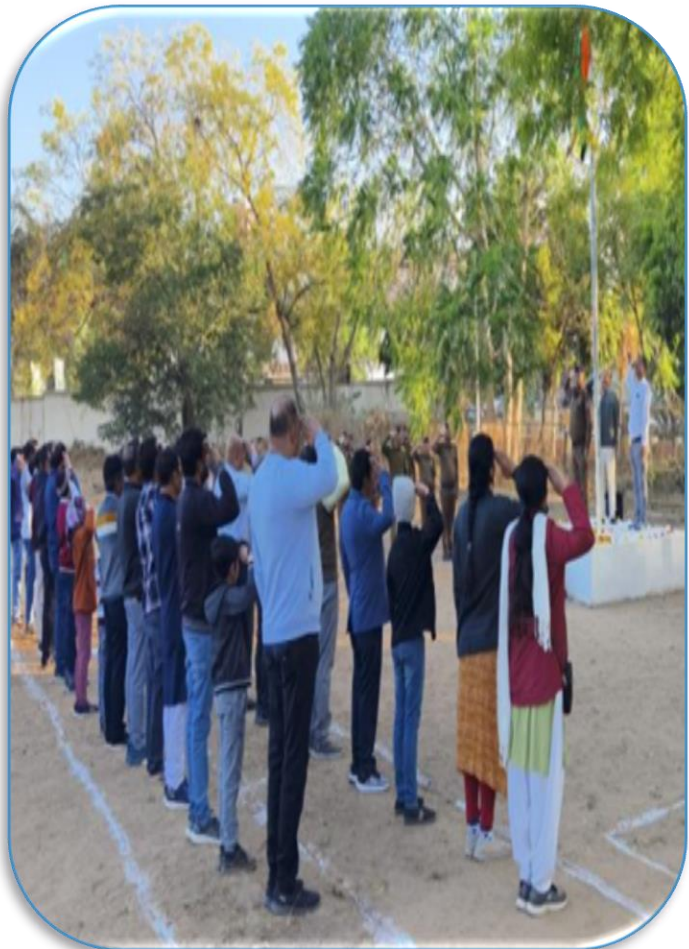
76TH REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION
